Forum attendees are interested in sessions that go beyond describing assessment processes to providing specific examples of assessment results and sharing how the results are being used to inform institutional practices. To the extent it is possible, we encourage you to focus on assessment results and address the entire assessment “loop” (i.e., Goals/Questions, Gathering Evidence, Interpretation, Use).

Proposal Format: All proposals should include the following:

- Cover Sheet with name, title, affiliation, address, telephone, email, and fax number for all presenters. The primary contact person should be identified in the case of multiple presenters.
- Presentation type, e.g. panel, single presenter.
- Presentation Focus (e.g., General Education, Assessment How-To's, etc.)
- Proposed Audience, e.g., assessment beginners or veterans, faculty, administrators.
- Session Title, and abstract of no more than 50 words (for use in conference previews and/or final program).
- Session Description that includes the objectives of the session, institutional impact (e.g., curricular or co-curricular improvement), the applicability of the information to other institutions, and opportunities for audience participation. Please limit description to 2-3 pages.
- Audio-Visual Equipment needed for presentation.

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
